COMMUNITY UPDATE

Recent flooding in North Queensland has caused delays in construction on Dunk Island Spit due to the closure of highways restricting access to crew and equipment and water damage to open trenches. The impact has pushed back progress, however Dunk Island Group remains committed to opening as soon as construction and landscaping is complete.

Construction currently underway on Dunk Island Spit includes a full service cafe/bar as well as power and sewerage infrastructure upgrades and landscaping.

Sand nourishment to restore the Brammo Bay foreshore has also been extended to remediate damage caused in the recent weather event. All visitors to the island are warned that access to the jetty-side beach is restricted during sand works which is expected to continue to late February.

Campground bookings will open as soon as construction is complete and a precise opening date has been confirmed. All community members who wish to receive an alert once bookings have opened are encouraged to register for the mailing list at info@dunkislandcamp.com.au.
